Girl Scouts of Sonoma Valley are honored to be leading the Valley of the Moon Vintage Festival Parade, held on Sunday, September 25. Sonoma Valley Girl Scouts will be the first to march in the parade and help to carry Girl Scout banners, Parade flags and signs. All Sonoma Valley Girl Scouts are invited to march.

We strongly encourage you to wear your uniform. Please try to wear vest/sash or Daisy pinafores over a white shirt and khaki pants/Capri/short/skirt. Adult volunteers are also asked to wear Girl Scout clothing/uniform with a white shirt and khaki bottom if possible.

The parade forms at 10:15 am and steps off at 11am. Please arrive at 10:15am to get organized before the parade begins. The parade staging area is the parking lot area by the little league fields on First Street East. Parade goes down First Street East, around the plaza and back up First Street West. Parents who are not walking can pick up their daughter pick up their girls on First Street West, just down from Spain Street – however we strongly encourage at least one parent to walk along side us. We will be leading the parade and done first – so the girls can then find a spot and watch the rest of the parade and will be dismissed as soon as we are done walking – so parents need to be ready to pick up their daughter as soon as we cross the finish line.

All Girls/Adults who participate are eligible to add the "Parade" rocker to the back of their uniform under the new 100 patch. The 100 anniversary patch and parade rocker are available for purchase at any Council retail location.

- Wear vest/sash, white shirt, khaki bottom
- Hat and Sunblock
- Water bottle – It's going to be warm
