First Girl Scout: The Life of Juliette Gordon Low

Juliette Gordon Low-Daisy, as her friends and family called her-was a remarkable woman with ideas that were ahead of her time (1860-1927). She witnessed important eras in U.S. history, from the Civil War and Reconstruction to westward expansion to post-World War I. And she made history by founding the first national organization to bring girls from all backgrounds into the out-of-doors: the Girl Scouts of the USA.

Daisy created controversy by encouraging girls to prepare for both traditional homemaking responsibilities as well as for roles as professional women-in the arts, sciences, and business-and for active citizenship outside the home. The group she founded was open to girls from all races and ethnicities, and welcomed girls with disabilities at a time when they were usually excluded. Because of her vision and determination, the Girl Scouts still do all of these things-and more-today. It is a universally recognized organization that counts more than 3 million women and girls as members.
