How to Nominate Someone for an Award

- 1. Complete the required form listed after each award. Clearly state the personal achievements of the candidate, and specifically state the reasons that the candidate's achievements meet the criteria for this particular award.
- 2. Recruit additional people to write the required letters of endorsement (this only applies to the *Outstanding Leader* award): Be sure to communicate the deadline for submission and to whom they should return the completed letter.
- 3. Return all forms and endorsement letters to Carol Short 707-292-6538 (Service Unit Adult Recognitions Chairperson) by Friday March 16, 2012. Forms can be mailed to Sonoma Girl Scouts- Awards, PO Box 299, El Verano, CA 95433

- The Outstanding Volunteer is a national award, and it is awarded by service units at local service unit meetings. - Years of Service Pin Recognition for number of years of active service as an adult member. Pins are available in 5-year increments: 5, 10, 15... For 20 years and above, volunteers are recognized at one of the Adult Recognition Ceremonies.

- Numeral Guards (Years of Membership) Recognition for number of combined years as a girl and adult member. Pins are available in 5-year increments; 5, 10, 15, 20, 25... For 30 years and above, recipients are recognized at one of the Adult Recognition Ceremonies. Be sure to include the names/years of any of the girls in your troop.

- Green Angel Award The service unit's volunteer-approved adult volunteer who brought Girl Scout program to her/his service unit in the most creative or innovative way for the year. - Family of the Year Award Minimum of three years of outstanding service, such as, supporting their troop, camps, special events, product sales, or have fulfilled other significant roles.
